Geelong Schools Music & Movement Festival Code of Conduct



It is requested that teachers read the following Code of Conduct and monitor student behaviour on the day to ensure a rewarding and enjoyable experience.

Responsibility for Students

Whilst at Geelong Arts Centre, the responsibility for student behaviour lies with the classroom teachers/carers from the visiting school.

The Geelong Arts Centre reserve the right to ask any visiting school to remove a student/s whose behaviour is deliberately and consistently disruptive or endangers the welfare of other people within the venue such as; venue staff, the general public, facilitators, teachers and/or other students. Sufficient classroom teachers/carers from the visiting school should be in attendance so that the remaining students are supervised.

Students are required to:

- Behave in a courteous and responsible manner at all times.
- Use the handrails when going up and down any stairs.
- Keep their pace to a walk inside the venue.
- Keep their conversation / voices at a respectable level.
- Always have teacher/carer with them when leaving the group (e.g. going to the toilet).

Student Teacher Ratio

The Department of Education and Training requires a minimum of 1 adult per group of 20 students. If a CRT is accompanying a class, please flag with the Creative Learning Team at Geelong Performing Arts Centre.

Please note that the supervising teachers/carer should bring a class list which includes all the names of the students and adults attending the excursion, to ensure that all attendees are accounted for in the event that a venue needs to be evacuated.

Commitment to Child Safety

All children and young people participating in a program at Geelong Arts Centre have the right to feel and be safe, knowing that their welfare is always our first priority. At Geelong Arts Centre we have zero tolerance to child abuse and aim to create a child safe and friendly environment where all children can participate and have fun.

Terms and Conditions

Payment and Invoicing

Cost per student is \$4. Final numbers will need to be reported to Geelong Arts Centre by Monday 21st July which will allow us to issue invoices to schools before the program. No further changes to student numbers can be made after 21st July. Payment is due no later than 2 weeks before the performance week. Schools that have not pre-paid will not be permitted to participate and refunds will not be issued for student non-attendance.

Cancellation

If a school cancels their participation on or after the **Monday** 1st **September 2025**, registration fees will be retained and not refunded/charged in full.

In the event that the Festival is cancelled due to COVID-19 related restrictions, a full refund will be issued to all registered schools.

COVID Safety

All schools must adhere to strict COVID-safety rules in place at the venue at the time of the event, including providing contact tracing lists of all attendees, and any government mandates at the time of the event. The venue COVID plan will be shared with you closer to the event.
